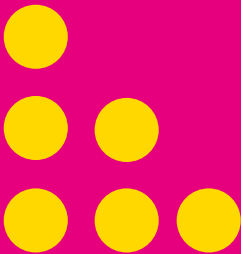

Creating habitats for birds and predatory insects can keep the pests down. Alternatively look to use biological controls to tackle your pest problems.

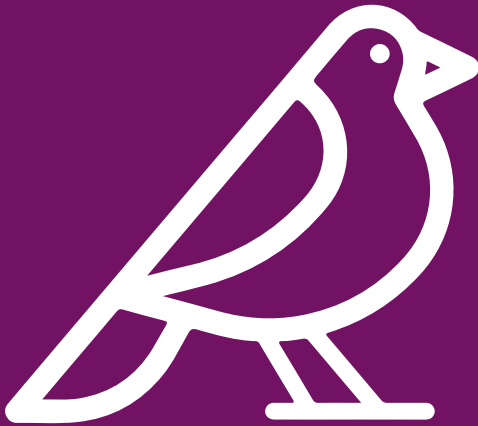
